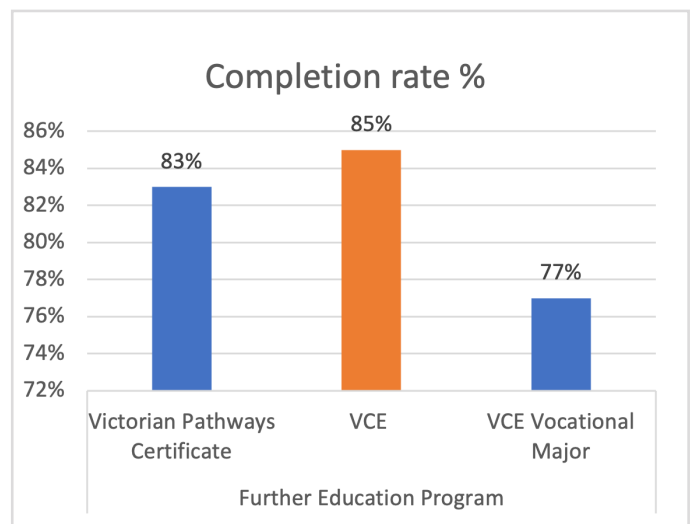
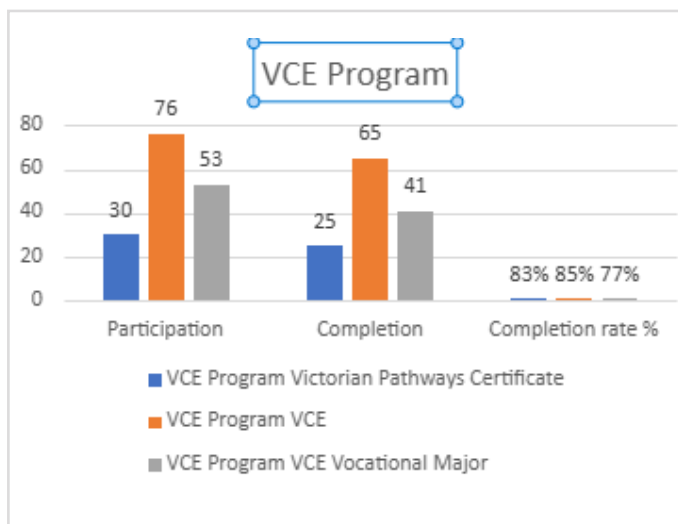

The Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) is offered to students aged 16–25 seeking to complete Years 11 and 12 in a flexible and inclusive learning environment.

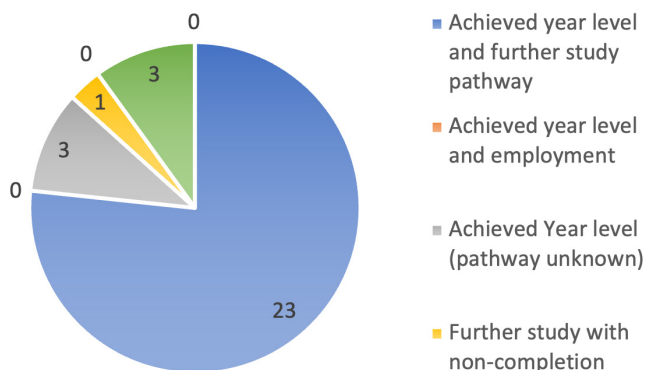
Through the VCE Vocational Major (VM) and the Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC), students participate in practical, hands-on learning. These programs are designed to develop essential literacy, numeracy, personal development and workplace skills, equipping students for life beyond school.

Learning is tailored to individual interests while encouraging collaboration through group-based experiences. Students benefit from a supportive environment with opportunities to participate in structured workplace learning, VET Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS) programs, and School-Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SBATs).

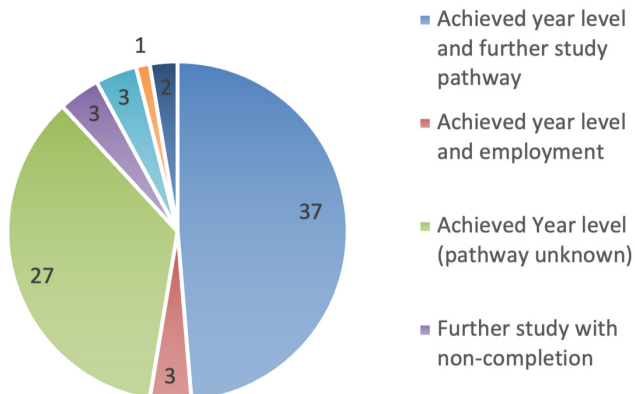
The Senior Secondary College provides clear pathways, preparing students for university, further education and training, apprenticeships, traineeships, and employment.



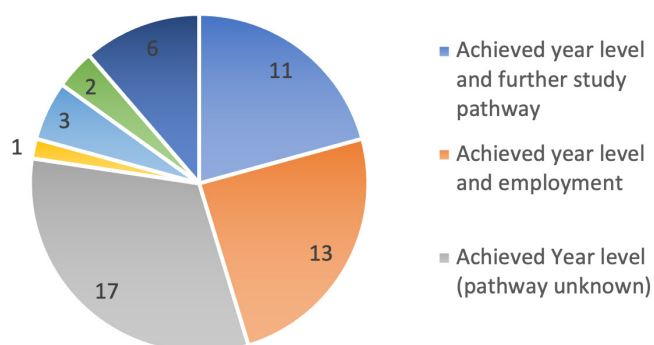
Victorian Pathways Certificate
