Since welcoming two Japanese wool students at The Gordon in 1920, the institute has trained students from more than 75 countries in a range of certificate, diploma and advanced diploma courses. Our students find The Gordon is more than just quality Australian education and training - it is an experience that creates and supports lifelong friendships.

The Gordon also has a long history of delivering offshore programs and maintaining successful training delivery partnerships in Asia. Competency training programs aim to build the capability of overseas vocational teaching staff by empowering them through training, mentoring and coaching to realise their full potential.

The Gordon has a long and proud involvement with WorldSkills, officially joining the prestigious international championships of vocational skills when it was established in 1982. Since then a large number of students across various skill sets have found success at national and international levels and the calibre of The Gordon's teaching staff is also showcased at these events with a number of highly skilled teachers taking on roles as judges both nationally and internationally.

Connecting with Asia

Our increased strategic focus with selected partners in the Asia region has resulted in new partnerships under development:

- Shandong Agricultural Engineering University Cooperation Agreement (MoU) and Application for dual award delivery including our Certificate IV in Accounting.
- Weifang Vocational College Cooperation Agreement (MoU) and Application for dual award delivery including our Diploma of Business and Certificate III in Children's Services.
- In 2019 The Gordon began delivering the Diploma of Building and Construction to Chongqing Jianzhou College (CJC) students in China. By the end of 2020, more than 60 Chinese students had successfully enrolled in the course. In 2020 The Gordon signed an agreement with the Chongqing Centre for International Education Exchange, this partnership gives The Gordon access to teacher training and other professional development programs to one of the largest municipalities in China, boasting a population of 34 million.

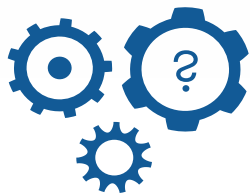

The Gordon's popular TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training & Assessment (TAE), is the qualification that is needed to become a leader, trainer and assessor in an individual's chosen field. Becoming a trainer can be achieved through the TAE course and its passionate, supportive trainers. This course is also ideal for employers interested in giving their staff the opportunity to further their personal development and career growth. Employers will have access to increased skills and experience within their staff.

The Gordon delivers 'best in class' stimulating education and provides both on-campus and work place-based training programs at the apprenticeship, traineeship, certificate, and diploma levels. Teaching staff enable and empower their students to be the best version of themselves and have substantial industry experience, are well respected industry figures, completing a cycle that links students, industry, and staff. The Gordon creates lifelong learners who are job ready and able to navigate the new world of work.

Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations

Transport and logistics are one of Australia's fastest-growing industries, offering a variety of employment opportunities. Understanding logistics including the systems, structures and processes that are in place to plan and implement the flow of goods and services is essential to effective business operations. This course provides pathways to higher qualification in transport and logistics.

Early Childhood Education and Care (ECEC)

There is a strong future demand for Childcare educators. Early Childhood and Education Care (ECEC) courses delivered by The Gordon are highly regarded in the sector due to the quality training and necessary skills and practical experience students gain, preparing them adequately for the demands of the sector. Over 90% of students that complete ECEC training are employed prior to completing the course. Additionally, students are often signed as trainees after completing their first or second placement due to the quality of education and employability skills gained at The Gordon.

Professional teachers and quality programs prepare students for rewarding careers supporting the growth and development of young children, and their families. Accredited courses include the Certificate III and Diploma in ECEC, with traineeships and university pathways available to students.

These courses are designed to provide the practical skills, knowledge and qualifications to confidently and appropriately interact with young children in a wide range of education settings across the region. This includes understanding and dealing with childhood behaviours and designing and teaching lessons in areas such as literacy, numeracy and creativity.

Cookery and Hospitality

The Gordon Culinary School is the number one provider of cookery and patisserie training in the Greater Geelong region. These courses are delivered by world-class teachers who possess a wealth of knowledge, share current trends, and teach hands-on skills and experience to prepare students for a rewarding career.

The city campus is home to a \$23.5m culinary school that was officially opened in September 2022. It features cutting-edge food training kitchens equipped with the latest sustainable cookery equipment, a bakery training facility, barista academy and café and an alfresco dining area.

Diploma of Food Science and Technology

This three-year joint program ran 5 cohorts from 2013 to 2019 with 159 students, and 89% completion rate. The course was delivered in China by Australian teachers from The Gordon who had extensive food manufacturing industry experience and provided expert insights into all aspects of the food industry including its challenges and opportunities. The course consisted of six semesters. Students studied English and Chinese units in the first year. The Australian program was delivered in the third, fourth and fifth semesters. Students also completed their internship in the sixth semester. The program equipped students to work in a management role in technical or quality departments of the food industry, overseeing the production of: general food processing, meat, seafood, poultry including chicken meat and egg processing, dairy processing, confectionery, beverages, and baking and cereals.



Certificate IV in Cyber Security

Cyber security is an evolving challenge requiring significant collaboration between industry and government to build resilient systems. As a growing threat, it is critical that systems, networks and programs are fully protected from Cyber crime.

The Certificate IV in Cyber Security is a technician level qualification that provides graduates with the knowledge and a comprehensive set of technical skills that enables them to:

- monitor the risk of cyber security attacks
- implement appropriate software
- use a range of tools and procedures to mitigate cyber security threats
- protect an organisation from insider security breaches
- develop systems to minimise network vulnerabilities and risks.

Graduates of the course can seek employment as cyber security practitioners in a range of commercial enterprises/organisations and government bodies. Job roles include:

- Security Operations Centre (SOC) Analyst
- Cyber Security Analyst
- Networking Security Support officer.

This course provides an introduction into information communication technology (ICT) and Cyber Security studies and provides pathways into higher level studies.

Health and Community

The Health and Community programs at The Gordon are highly regarded within the sector and are designed to give people from all backgrounds the opportunity to pursue rewarding and fulfilling careers in acute health, aged care and community health. The institute partners with major employers in the health sector to support skills development within the existing and future workforce. These popular courses equip students with the knowledge and practical skills needed to work in the rapidly evolving industry.

In 2020 The Gordon launched its inaugural Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP), an important element of ongoing engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. In 2021, the \$450,000 Kitjarra Centre was officially opened by Minister for Training and Skills and Higher Education, Gayle Tierney. The Centre, developed as part of the \$23.5 million refurbishment and modernisation of The Gordon's culinary school at the City Campus, houses the Aboriginal Education Unit and is an important part of the Victorian Government's Marrung: Aboriginal Education Plan 2016-2026 designed to increase engagement and participation of Aboriginal students in vocational education and training.

Overall, the institute aims to ensure everyone at the institute, including the International community, feels included valued and respected and has access to equal opportunity, which supports full participation at work and in the broader community. The Gordon strives to retain the diverse workforce talent and support staff to maintain a long and productive working career.
