

Marriage Celebrant Ongoing Professional Development

Steps for Commonwealth-Registered Marriage Celebrants for completing 2021 OPD:

- 1. Complete the one hour mandatory Compulsory Activity (Legal Quiz) administrated by the Attorney-General's Department. It is free of charge through the celebrant self-service portal. <u>https://marriage.ag.gov.au/mcportal/</u>
- 2. Select and Enrol in any combination of elective activities to the total of four hours from the listing below.
