The residence is located at the East Geelong Campus. It is two-storey and comprises three separate wings, accommodating 50 furnished bedrooms. Communal living areas are situated centrally on each floor, with couches, dining, TV and DVD facilities.

Fully equipped kitchen and bathroom facilities are shared between a maximum of 6 residents. Laundry and drying amenities are also available. A cleaner is provided for the general living areas, however it is the responsibility of the students to keep their own rooms and kitchen tidy.

Assistance

Additionally, each of the wings has a Resident Assistant who handles any minor issues, which are then relayed to the Manager. The lease agreement and additional rules set out the obligations and behaviours that are expected.

Rental Rates

To live on Res you must be at least 18 years of age. Rates (as at 1 Jan 2023):

Long term: \$160 per week

Short term: \$150 per week (small room) or \$170 per week (large room)

Bond: \$620

Two weeks rent in advance and a bond of \$620 is required initially, and refunded at the conclusion of the residence period provided there is no damage and room condition is approved by Residence Manager. While staying at the Residence students are required to provide their own bedding, cooking utensils and personal items. Parking permits for the student carpark are available to residents. Regular public transport is available at the front of the Residence.
