‡ All Deakin University applicants, including those applying for guaranteed entry courses, must meet the English language criteria, minimum admission criteria and readmission clauses to be considered for entry as outlined at <https://policy.deakin.edu.au/document/view-current.php?id=35>. RPL will be assessed separately from entry. All applicants will be considered by selections officers on the basis for their ability to meet the educational demands of the course and their likelihood of success. Selection officers may consider, among other factors, your complete academic record including any studies completed before, during and after the listed TAFE qualification. If they feel that you will not be successful in the course, Deakin University may reject your application.

All international students should apply at [deakin.edu.au/apply](https://deakin.edu.au/apply). Course entry is competitive, not guaranteed for international students. Applicants are advised to support their application with their study results, a resume/CV, personal statement and/or any other supporting documentation including portfolios and tests when relevant. International students must hold a valid Australian visa throughout their enrolment at Deakin, unless they are enrolled in Cloud Campus.

#### LEGEND FOR COURSE ENTRY FOR DOMESTIC STUDENTS ONLY

GE Course entry is guaranteed, if listed Diploma is completed at The Gordon in the past 5 years and proof of completion is provided.

CV and PS Students with a non graded qualification will be assessed on a case by case basis on submission of study results, CV/resume showing experience including placements (paid and unpaid), and a personal statement detailing motivation to study this Bachelor at Deakin University.

GC Course entry is guaranteed if listed Diploma is completed at The Gordon in the last 5 years and proof of completion is provided. However campus offered may vary to that applied for if demand exceeds places at the desired campus. In this case, applicants will ranked according to the information provided in their study results, resume/CV and/or personal statement.

CP Course entry is competitive, not guaranteed. Applicants are advised to support their application with their study results, a resume/CV, personal statement and/or any other supporting documentation. Bachelor of Nursing applicants must be registered with (or eligible to register with) AHPRA.

ED Course entry is competitive, not guaranteed. Applicants are advised to support their application with their study results, a resume/CV, personal statement and/or any other supporting documentation. Course entry considers additional criteria such as completion of a selection tool for non-academic attributes as well as evidence or tests of literacy and numeracy competencies. PF Course entry is competitive, not guaranteed. Applicants are advised to support their application with their study results, a resume/CV, personal statement and/or any other supporting documentation. Course entry considers additional criteria such as portfolios that apply in addition to past study.
