Checklist

- ✓ A screen pin lock is required on your device. You are able to remove or change the screen lock once the connection process is completed. Please note that other forms of screen lock are not guaranteed to work.
- ✓ Close all other applications and windows on your device.
- ✓ Your device has the correct date and time if this is incorrect, you will be unable to connect to The Gordon WiFi.
- ✓ The Google Chrome browser is installed and accessible.
- ✓ You are able to login to Gordon computers using your username and password.
- ✓ There is at least 5mb free space on your device.

Please note the following:


- Follow each step in this guide, and do not skip ahead.
- The below instructions may vary between different Android devices and operating systems.
- An application called QuickConnect will be installed on your device, and will request access permissions.






1) Open Settings.



2) Open Wi-Fi Settings. It may show up in your device as Network & Internet.



3) Open Wi-Fi, and confirm it is enabled.





4) Select Gordon WiFi from the list of available networks.




- 5) You will be presented with a login page. Confirm your connection settings are set as below:
 - a. EAP method: PEAP.
 - b. **Phase-2 authentication**: None.
 - c. CA certificate: Do not validate.





6) Scroll down and expand **Advanced options**, and change **Privacy** to **Use device MAC** – leave the other settings as default



7) Enter your username into the **Identity** field and your network password within **Password**, then select **CONNECT**.



8) You may see a message underneath Gordon WiFi saying **Tap here to sign in to network – <u>do not tap this option</u>**







9) Instead, open a new instance of Google Chrome.



You should be automatically redirected to a Gordon sign in page once you open Chrome – if you are not, attempt to access any external website to force the redirect. You can also access the page manually by entering the URL fencppm.gordontafe.edu.au

10)Log In using your Gordon network username and password.


11) Once you've logged in, select Install QuickConnect.



12) An instance of the **Google Play Store** will open. Select **Install** to install the **ClearPass QuickConnect** app.




13) Once the application has installed, select Open.

14) QuickConnect will open with a disclaimer. Read this and select Continue.




15) Once prompted for permissions, select **Allow** and **Allow all the time** for the requested permissions.

16) You should see the below screen in QuickConnect. **Do not select OK**; instead go back to **Chrome**.




17) In Chrome, select Install Network Profile.





18) This will download the quick1x.networkconfig file. Open the file.



19) This will open the network profile using **QuickConnect**. **QuickConnect** will then prompt you to forget the Wi-Fi. Select **WI-FI SETTINGS**.




20) This will redirect you to your device's **Wi-Fi Settings**. Open the **Gordon WiFi** and select **FORGET**. If you are not redirected, manually open **Wi-Fi Settings**.





21) Once The Gordon WiFi network has been forgotten, return to **QuickConnect**, where it will have started the provisioning process. Allow up to a minute for this process to complete.



22) Once complete, you will see Your device is now successfully connected to the Gordon WiFi Network in QuickConnect.

23) Returning to **Chrome**, you should now see the **Device provisioning complete** message.

You're done, your Android device is now connected to the Gordon WiFi network. You can follow the link to return to the Gordon website.
